1. 51% of students and others opined that depth of the course content including project/internship work if any is excellent, 29% expressed very good, 17% opined good and remaining felt satisfactory.
2. 50% of students and others expressed extent of coverage of course is excellent, 30% expressed very good, 14% opined good and remaining felt satisfactory.
3. 44% of students and others expressed that applicability /relevance to real life situations is excellent, 35% is very good, 14% opined good and remaining felt satisfactory.
4. 70% of students and others opined that the learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual skills, analytical abilities & broadening perspectives) is excellent, 19% is very good, 10% expressed good and remaining felt satisfactory.
5. 25% of students and others expressed that clarity and relevance of textual reading material is excellent, 31% is very good, 18% expressed good and remaining felt satisfactory.
6. 55% of students and others felt that relevance of additional source material (library) is excellent, 28% felt very good, 11% expressed good, and remaining felt satisfactory.

- Among the 17 responded alumni, 11 are the members of the S.K.S.D. Mahila College Old students Associations.
- After receiving the response sheets, they were tabulated question-wise with percentage The percentage were shown in bar charts for all the twenty questions.
- After reviewing the analysis, the authorities have taken necessary measures for the improvement.
- Opinion of the respondents:
- 97 percent of the respondents aware of the community service activities taken up the college.
- 97 percent felt the college serves of serves the society at large apart from its academic activity.
- 91 percent aware of the on/off campus recruitment drives held in the campus and other intuitions.
- 91 percent satisfied with the facilities available to the students.
- 91 percent the goals and objectives of the college suit the present scenario.
- 89 percent satisfied with the functioning of the college since 2007, in the post- NAAC period.
- 89 Percent following the activities of the college covered by the media or otherwise.
- 86 Percent aware of the programmes such as career guidance, communication skills, soft skills, yoga etc., conducted I the college.
- 86 percent aware of Co-curricular activities such as seminars, workshops, guest lecturers etc.
- 86 percent noticed the constant improvement in the infrastructure provided by the college Management.

Opinion of the respondents:

- 92 percent of the respondents are aware of the campus recruitment drives being held in the college.
- 89 percent of members felt that the college serves the society at large apart from its academic activity.
- 89 percent of respondent satisfied with the functioning of the college since 2007, in the post – NAAC Period.
- 86 percent of the respondents opined that academic activities of the college meet the job requirement and agreed that the goals and objectives of the college suit the present scenario.
- 84 percent have noticed the improvement of the institution with regard to discipline in the campus, number of working days, pass percentage etc.
